1.	The book of Lamentations consists of five laments that Jeremiah wrote after the Babylonians Jerusalem in 587-588 BC.
2.	During his forty years of ministry, Jeremiah tried to persuade the leaders of Judah to turn back to God but they refused. Jeremiah is often called "the prophet."
3.	After he described hopelessness, Jeremiah focused on the hope we have in God, no matter how our situation might be.
4.	Jeremiah from dwelling on his misery to remembering God's mercy. He still experienced pain and sorrow, but he also called to mind the of God, and this gave him hope.
