

**“The Faithfulness of God”**  
**Lamentations 3:21-23**

1. The book of Lamentations consists of five laments that Jeremiah wrote after the Babylonians \_\_\_\_\_ Jerusalem in 587-588 BC.
2. During his forty years of ministry, Jeremiah tried to persuade the leaders of Judah to turn back to God but they refused. Jeremiah is often called “the \_\_\_\_\_ prophet.”
3. After he described hopelessness, Jeremiah focused on the hope we have in God, no matter how \_\_\_\_\_ our situation might be.
